Location

Thornliebank is a suburban area in East Renfrewshire, in the west central Lowlands of Scotland. Part of the Greater Glasgow conurbation, it is located on the Auldhouse Burn about 6 miles south of Glasgow city centre. The neighbouring East Renfrewshire town of Giffnock lies directly to the east, with Rouken Glen Park to the south. The site is located at the northern end of Spiersbridge Road, opposite its junction with Rouken Glen Road in a mainly residential area. The M77 is located nearby as is Thornliebank mainline rail station.

Description

An irregular shaped site, previously used for advertising hoardings fronting Spiersbridge Road totalling about 558 sq m (6,001 sq ft) 0.056 hectares (0.138 acres). The site to the rear may be suitable for a variety of different uses and possible development, subject to obtaining any necessary consents.
