Location

Hornsey is an area of North London, within the London Borough of Haringey, and about 6 miles from Central London. The High Street offers a good range of retail, restaurant and pubs and the area is known as the location of Alexandra Park and Palace. Rail transport is via Hornsea rail station with the tube at Turnpike Lane on the Piccadilly Line.

Beresford Road is one of a network of roads lying off busy Green Lane, a short walk from Hornsey rail station and Turnpike Lane. The property lies close to Green Lane where there are retail and cafe facilities.

Description

The property comprises a traditional two storey mid-terrace house of brick construction beneath a hipped slate roof. The front elevation benefits from bay windows on ground and first floors.

The property is currently arranged as two x one bedroom flats, the one on the ground floor benefiting from the rear garden. The property is heated but this has not been tested.
