Location

Swansea is a coastal city and Wales' second largest city lying about 41 miles north west of Cardiff. It can be accessed via the A483 and A4217, which provide access to the M4 motorway at junctions 42-45. Swansea railway station provides regional and national rail links including direct services to Cardiff and London Paddington.

Llangyfelach Road forms part of the B4489 about one mile north of the city centre and close to the Liberty Stadium. The site lies on the west side of the road opposite its junction with Pentre Mawr Road and Pentrehafod School.

Description

An irregular shaped former advertising hoarding site of approximately 408.92 sq m (4,402 sq ft). The site commands a prominent main road position and may offer alternative use or development potential subject to obtaining the necessary consents.
