### Location

Oxford lies on the banks of the River Thames and is a major tourist destination as well as the home of the oldest university in the English speaking world lying about 55 north west of London and 24 miles north west of Reading. It is accessed from the Oxford Ring Road that surrounds the city and provides direct access to the A34 to the west, The M40 motorway (junction 9) to the north and the M4 motorway (junction 13) to the south. Oxford railway station provides regional and national rail links including direct services to London Paddington and Oxford Airport lies about 8 miles to the north west of the City.

Combe Road lies in the suburb of Jericho just to the north of the city Centre. It runs west from Canal Street and was the filming location for the first ever Episode of Inspector Morse in 1986. The property lies to the rear of number 10 Combe Road, immediately next door to College Cruisers.

# **Description**

A small rectangular parcel of land totalling approximately 34.37 sq m (370 sq ft) lying adjacent to the Oxford Canal and Castle Mill Stream. The site is part fenced and part walled and contains an electricity sub-station.
